Meeting Report - November 2005

The Canadian On-Farm Food Safety Working (COFFS) Working Group met in Vancouver on the evening of 9 November 2005 between its workshop on the management system requirements (November 7th and 8th) and its workshop on internal auditing (November 9th and 10th). This report highlights the matters discussed, key issues and the directions taken during the Working Group meeting.

Delivery Options Project - Phase 4

The primary purpose of this meeting was review the status of the Working Group's delivery options project and to respond to several matters identified by AAFC in the funding application review process. The Working Group agreed to make changes to the project and identified a process for establishing the steering committee. This project had been proposed to the Working Group by the new Ontario On-Farm Food Safety Committee as a means of providing additional costing information to national producer organizations and their provincial members about implementation options. The project's scope was clarified and the role of stakeholders from across Canada, both national and provincial producer organizations finalized.

Communication and Promotion Activities

The Working Group was informed that AAFC had approved the communications plan and the funding application. An update was provided on the website project and plans were agreed to for the display project.

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
